

\$1 Million National Championship Game Sweepstakes Official Rules

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. A PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. If you request the Sweepstakes URL via text-messaging, you will receive two (2) text messages in response to your request from an automated system. Message and data rates may apply. Text STOP to 35350 to opt out. Text HELP to 35350 for information. Consent is not required to buy goods and services. You may not be able to participate by text messages through all wireless carriers.

1. Eligibility: \$1 Million National Championship Game Sweepstakes (the "Sweepstakes") is open only to legal residents of specific states (as outlined below in Section 3) within the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia who are at least the age of majority in their state of residence at the time of entry: eighteen (18) in most states; 19 in Alabama (AL) and Nebraska (NE) and 21 in Mississippi (MS) at the time of entry. Administrator's computer is the official time-keeping device for the Sweepstakes.

4. How to Enter: During the Promotion Period, visit www.eckrichfootball.com and follow the links and instructions to complete and submit the registration form including a valid email address and your state of residency. If you are a college student, enter the state location of your university or college that you are attending during the college football season. You automatically will receive one (1) entry into the National

Championship Game drawing and one (1) entry into any applicable Entry Period drawing that you are eligible for based on the table in Section 3 above.

Limit: Each entrant may receive one (1) entry into the National Championship Game drawing per day during the Promotion Period; each entrant may receive one (1) entry per day during the Promotion Period for each Entry Period he/she is eligible. 5. Prize Drawings: Administrator is an independent judging organization whose decisions as to the administration and operation of the Sweepstakes and the selection of the potential winners are final and binding in all matters related to the Sweepstakes. Administrator will randomly select the potential Entry Period winners from all eligible entries received during the applicable Entry Period on or around the dates listed in Section 3 above. Non-winning Entry Period entries will not carry over into subsequent Entry Period drawings. Administrator will randomly select the potential National Championship Game Prize winner from all eligible entries received during the Promotion Period, on or around the date listed in Section 3 above. The potential winners will be notified by email, or phone. 9. General Conditions: Sponsor reserves the right to cancel, suspend and/or modify the Sweepstakes, or any part of it, if any fraud, technical failures, human error or any other factor impairs the integrity or proper functioning of the Sweepstakes, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. In such event, Sponsor, in its sole discretion, may elect to hold a random drawing from among all eligible entries received up to the date of discontinuance for any or all of the prizes offered herein. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Sweepstakes or to be acting in violation of the Official Rules of this or any other promotion or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Force Majeure: If any event described herein cannot be held on the scheduled date, or if any party cannot perform any or all of its obligations hereunder, because of an event of force majeure, including, without limitation, inclement weather, unplayable conditions, labor actions or work stoppages (including, without limitations, strikes and lockouts), nature calamities, national emergencies, declarations of war, terrorist threat or act of terrorism, acts of God, or for any other reason beyond the reasonable control of the performing party and/or the cancellation of the event and a good faith rescheduling of such event cannot be achieved, the delay and/or cancellation of such event and/or the party's failure to perform its obligation(s) shall not be considered a breach of these Official Rules and each party shall be relieved of its obligations hereunder in connection with such event or obligations.

10. If the disagreement stated in the Demand is not resolved to your satisfaction within 10 business days after it is received, and you intend on taking legal action, you agree that you will file a demand for arbitration with the American Arbitration Association (the "Arbitrator"). This arbitration provision limits the ability of you, Administrator, and Sponsor to litigate claims in court and you, Administrator, and Sponsor each agree to waive your respective rights to a jury trial or a state or federal judge. You agree that you will not file any lawsuit against Administrator or Sponsor in any state or federal court. You agree that if you do sue in state or federal court, and Administrator or Sponsor brings a successful motion to compel arbitration, you must pay all fees and costs incurred by Administrator and Sponsor in court, including reasonable attorney's fees. For any such filing of a demand for arbitration, you must effect proper service under the rules of the Arbitrator and notice to the Notice Address may not be sufficient. If, for any reason, the American Arbitration Association is unable to conduct the arbitration, you may file your case with any national arbitration company. The Arbitrator shall apply the AAA Consumer-Related Disputes Supplementary Procedure effective September 15, 2005 (as may be amended) and as modified by the agreement to arbitrate in this Dispute Resolution section. You agree that the Arbitrator will have sole and exclusive jurisdiction over any dispute you have with Administrator or Sponsor. The Federal Arbitration Act allows for the enforcement of arbitration agreements and governs the interpretation and enforcement of the agreement to arbitrate.

You agree that you will not file a class action or collective action against Administrator or Sponsor, and that you will not participate in a class action or collective action against them. You agree that you will not join your claims to those of any other person. Notwithstanding any other provision in the Official Rules, or the Administrator's Mobile Terms and Conditions, if this class action waiver is invalidated, then the agreement to arbitrate is null and void, as though it were never entered into, and any arbitration dispute at that time will be dismissed without prejudice and may be refiled in a court. Under no circumstances do you, Administrator, or Sponsor agree to class or collective procedures in arbitration or the joinder of

claims in arbitration. Administrator and Sponsor agree that we will submit all disputes with you to arbitration before the Arbitrator.

All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, or the rights and obligations of the entrant, Administrator, and Sponsor in connection with the Sweepstakes, or any claim or dispute that has arisen or may arise between you, Administrator and Sponsor, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Michigan without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules. The place of arbitration shall be Oakland County, Michigan.
